Albert Vermilia (George and Maria Vermillia) born December 14, 1825 at Brooklyn, Kings County, New York, married about 1848 Mary Salter who was born January __, 1831 in Washington County, New York, died _____. He died April 24, 1906. Her will is dated September 1925. Source Code #1, Biographical Vertical Files, Crandall Public Library, Center for Folklife, History and Cultural Programs, Glens Falls, New York and following records.

The two pages of material are devoted almost entirely to Albert Vermillia. One page consists of a brief biographical sketch (in outline form) of him prepared by historian Sherman Williams. Williams says that Albert Vermillia was born in New York City on December 14, 1825. His parents were George and Maria Vermillia (her maiden name is not given). He married Mary Salter of Glens Falls. Albert and Mary had three children. Only one named is Emma, who married J. W. Hunting. Albert Vermillia came to Warren County in 1842 and to Glens Falls in 1845. Soon afterward (probably about 1847) he opened a meat market. He died in Glens Falls on April 24, 1906. Source: Crandall Public Library, Glens Falls, New York. (Note: There is no one named Vermillia listed in New York City on the 1820 or 1830 Federal Census.)

Information from wills: Mary Vermillia --- Will dated September 1925. Daughter Emma Gilchrist, grandsons, A. Vermellia Hunting and J. Woodruff Hunting. Albert's will dated August 31, 1875 named daughter Emma Vermillia Hunting, minor son Albert, wife Mary, resident of Queensbury Township, Warren County, New York State. He died April 24, 1906, son not listed as heir.

Albert V. Brayton is listed in the Glens Falls, New York City Directory 1891-1892 as a butcher. Further checking on this family does not show any connection to Vermillia family names, perhaps Albert Vermillia was a family friend. Mary the mother of Albert Vermillia Brayton is not a V.
