

## **FIRST GENERATION**

David Vermilya, (UNKNOWN) born about 1799 in New York, married probably second or maybe third Almira \_\_\_\_\_ who was born about 1803 in Pennsylvania. There is a Hannah Vermilyea buried in the Old Port Byron Cemetery, Cayuga County, listed as wife of David Vermilya who died in 1847. It appears he may have left the area after the death of Hannah and went to Fayette County, Iowa where he died between 1855 and 1860.

It is possible that he is a brother of Elizabeth Vermilyea Mead, Unidentified. His son David is living with her family in Elmira, New York in 1850 and both appear near each other on early census records at Cayuga, Mentz.

He died after 1930 and probably before 1940, probably in California. California death records start in 1940 and he does not appear in these records.
