While a youth of immature years Frederick A. Ely worked on his uncle's schooner on Long Island Sound and at the same time attended public schools as opportunity offered. About 1870 he removed to Rockford, Ill., near which town he bought eighty acres of land, upon which he lived for five years. In 1875 he changed his location to St. Joseph, Mo., where he lived for a year, and in 1878 settled in Oregon City. His subsequent purchase of land and all around activity has won him an enviable reputation as a upbuilder and a public-spirited citizen. He has not been particularly active in politics, and may be said to be independant, voting rather for principle than party. In his family, is his wife, whom he married in New York, and who was formerly Christina Vermilyear, and three sons and one daughter. Of the children, D. C. is carrying on the mercantile business in Oregon City, with which his brother George B. was connected until the winter of 1903. The latter is now living in Oregon City, but since dissolving the partnership with his brother has been living retired. Charles is also a resident of Oregon City, and Clara is the wife of E. W. Williams of Oregon City.
