George W. Vermilyea, (UNKNOWN) born about 1830 in New York, could have married Rachel _____ who was born about 1834 in New York, if this is correct she was deceased by 1870. He married (could be second) Rosina Anspuke/Anspake who was born February 9, 1828 (computed from death date and age) in New York, died September 17, 1883 at Manhattan, New York, buried at Cypress Hills Cemetery, Brooklyn, New York. He died _____. Rosena listed as married on death certificate in 1883, so he probably died after that date, though not located after 1870. Source Codes #560, #561 and following records.

Not located in 1850. 1860 Federal Census New York, 10th Ward, Dist.1, New York City, June 8, 1860: George Vermilyea, age 30, caulker, born New York; Rachel (since there is record of Rosena Vermilyea dated 1858, I believe this name is in error, however birth date is off ?), age 26, born New York; Anna, age 5; George, age 5/12, all born New York State. 1870 Federal Census New York, New York, Ward 10, Dist. 6, December 1870: George Vermilye, age 38, laborer, born New York; Rosina, age 40, born New York; Anna, age 16; Robert, age 8, in school; John, age 13, all born New York. ????? is this same George? Could be Canal St., below Allen and N. Canal. 1870 Federal Census, New York, Ward 10 Dist. 8, August 6, 1870: George Vermilly, age 40, caulker, born New York; Rosina, age 45, keeping house; Anne, age 15; John, age 12; Robert, age 7. Not located in 1880. Neither he or the children are located on death index for NYC.

Rosina Vermilya, age 55 years, 7 months, 8 days, born New York, resident 52 years, Father: Anspuke, born Germany, Mother: Anna E. Anspuke, born US, died September 17, 1883, buried Cypress Hills Cemetery September 19, 1883. Married. (husband's name not listed) Note: She had been sick a long time. Died heart disease. Certificate #470722. FHL Film #1322647. Rosina is buried with a George White, the cemetery thinks they bought the single grave. Cemetery says that Rosina and George White aren't related, but then they don't know who they are either..... George White --- George W. Vermilyea????

- R4. John, born about 1858 in New York (George ??) Could he be a son of hers by previous marriage?? He is not listed in 1860.
- R5. George, born about 1860 in New York, died before 1870? Son, born to George and Rosina Vermilya, born March 21, 1860, 244 Monroe.
- R6. Robert, born 1861/1862 in New York. (There are records listed at Source Code #1 listing Robert Joseph Anspake, father Robert Vermilyea??? and Robert Vermilyea Anspake, parents William Anspake and Louise Huntley, Robert Vermilyea Anspake's date of birth is listed as March 14, 1855, so it does not appear to be this Robert. William and Louise are also the parents of George Washington Anspake, born 1856/1857. It appears that this William Anspake is the same William that appears in the household with Rosina in 1870, age 40, and is most likely her brother. His parents are listed as Frederick and Ann Eliza McNamera). Robert Vermilyea Anspake married November 20, 1872 in New York Jane Dale who was born January 30, 1854.
