James **Vermilye**, (Unknown) born early 1800's in New Jersey, married about 1839 Caroline Crane who was born about 1821 in New Jersey. He probably died or left the family about 1848-1849 in New Jersey. No record of death for him at that time in New Jersey located. She died _____, last located in 1850 at Newark, Essex County, New Jersey.

No James V. on the 1840 Census. 1850 Federal Census New Jersey, Essex, Newark, West Ward: Caroline Vermilyea, age 29, born New Jersey; Robert, age 10, born New Jersey, attending school; Oscar, age C/12 ??, born New Jersey.

This James Vermilye and the James Vermilye who married Ann Eliza Myers in 1847 at Newark, New Jersey are not the same person.

2. Robert, born about 1840 in New Jersey. Not located after 1850.
3. Oscar **Eugene**, born May 6, 1850 in New Jersey, married about 1888 Elizabeth Reese who was born June 1862/June 8, 1860 in Pennsylvania, died May 22, 1904 at Manhattan, New York. He died April 9, 1917 at Manhattan, New York. They are buried Hollywood Cemetery, Harrington, Kent County, Delaware. No record of children located.

1860 Federal Census New Jersey, Essex, Newark, Ward 7: Osca Vermilia, age 10, born 1849 in New Jersey. He is living in the household of John and Catherine McCail, ages 30 and 32, born Ireland. It appears they have two children of their own, and over 30 other young children in same household -- looks like children's home. Not located on the 1870 Federal Census. 1880 Federal Census New Jersey, Essex, Newark: Oscar Vermilyea, age 29, born New Jersey, parents born New Jersey, metal japaner. He is living with John J. Conklin, age 45, jewelry maker, born New York, parents born New York; Mary J., wife, age 49, born New Jersey, parents born New Jersey and other boarders. 1900 Federal Census New York, New York, Manhattan; Oscar E. Vermilyea, born March 1853, age 47, married 12 years, *born Pennsylvania, parents born Pennsylvania*, physician; Elizabeth, wife, born June 1862, age 37, married 12 years, no children, born Pennsylvania, parents born Pennsylvania. Living at West 41st. St., Manhattan. 1910 Federal Census Connecticut, Tolland, Coventry: Oscar E. Vermilyea, age 51, widower, *born Pennsylvania, parents born Pennsylvania*, farmer, horse farm; Annie Bower, servant, age 44, married twice, married 3 years, mother of no children, born New York, parents born unknown, house keeper, private family.

Father: James; Mother: Caroline Crane, both born US. Buried Harrington Cemetery, Harrington, Delaware, died French Hospital, Res. 720 West 181st, Manhattan. French Hospital is the old name for a hospital on 30th street in Manhattan.

Oscar could be the musician that wrote Helitrope Quick Step published in the Trenton Evening Times, December 20, 1895. There is no explanation about the reason the music is published there, no details.

Elizabeth Vermilye, died May 22, 1904, age 34, Student, lived in NYC 19 years, spinal meningites, residence 816 Broadway, married, buried Harrington, Delaware May 25, 1904. Certificate #19598, Film #1323052.
