Millison/Amelia Vermilya (UNKNOWN) born about January 6, 1793 (calculated from death record) in New York, married about 1815 (listed as about 1813 in Delaware County, New York in IGI, Source Code #1) Abel, son of Sheba and Catherine (Smith) Darrin who was born about 1791 (listed May 3, 1791 at Claverack, Columbia County, New York in IGI, Source Code #1) in Massachusetts, died after 1860 in Ohio. She died September 26, 1851 in Logan County, Ohio, buried in the Armstrong Cemetery, Miami Township, Ohio. Source Code #1 and following records.

Sheba Darrin lived at Kortwright, Delaware County, New York, listed on 1810 Federal Census. 1820 at Davenport, Delaware County, New York. Abel Darrin. 2 males -under 10; 1 male 26-45; 1 female under 10; 1 female 16-26. He married second June 17, 1858 at Shelby, Ohio Susannah Westfall (probably her married name as there is a 16 year old George Westfall living in the household and also a William Bierly, age 3 in 1860, relationships are not noted on this record) who was born about 1814 in Ohio, died _____. He married third Jane (_____) Collicutt who was born about 1838 in England, died _____. He died _____ (after 1880, probably in Wisconsin). available to verify this is the correct person. Source Code #1 shows the following for Latin Darrin: born 1816, Delaware, New York, father Abel, mother Amelia, married May 9, 1841 at Delaware, New York Margaret Schooler. Another listing shows him born 1813 at Logan, Miami, Ohio, marrying same person, same date, daughter of Benjamin Harrison and Sarah Jane (Davis) Schooler. Another listing shows him marrying June 17, 1858 at Shelby, Ohio Susannah Westfall. (I believe this to be correct as Benjamin Schooler is listed at Shelby, Ohio in 1840.) Let another listing Latten Darrin, married June 3, 1877 at Willow Spring Twp., Lafayette, Wisconsin Jane Collicut. The family from Delaware County, New York.

Caroline Cannon age 82, born Ohio, father born New York, mother born Connecticut, is still living in 1910 with same family at Chippewa, Stanley, Wisconsin. She now lists she is the mother of 6 children, 1 living. Caroline Cannon is reported dead in 1906. (Should be 1916?).

I do believe this is the correct family as Wisconsin Marriage records show: Frank M. Craig and Nellie Cannon married November 16, 1878 in Dunn County, Wisconsin. Frank, Nellie and Clifford are still living at Chippewa, Stanley, Wisconsin in 1920, no Caroline Cannon.

ALVAH STILES, Bureau, was born in Greene County, Ohio, February 21. 1831. He is the son of Abram and Sarah (Martin) Stiles, both natives of New York State, but who moved to Ohio in childhood, where they were married and lived until 1852, when they settled in this county. Abram Stiles was born January 1, 1806, and is still living in this county. His wife was born in 1808 and died in February, 1882. They were the parents of thirteen children, eight of whom reached maturity, viz.: Alvah; Urana Reynolds, of Washington Territory; Lucretia Pierce, of Bureau Township; Drazilla Clayton, of Walnut Township; Minerva Marsh, of Iowa; Elzina Phillips, of Walnut Township; Henry Stiles, of Iowa; Ellen Epperson, of Walnut Township. Alvah Stiles was reared in Logan County, Ohio, his parents having moved there when he was two years old. He was reared on a farm and educated in the common schools; many days of his young life were spent in the woods clearing and making rails. In the spring of 1854 he came to Bureau County, though he had been through the county prospecting in 1851 and 1852. He has since made this his home, with the exception of eighteen months in Kansas in 1859 and 1860. He was married in Logan County, Ohio, October 31, 1853, to Elvira Darrin. She was born in New York August 9, 1835, youngest daughter of Abel and Millison (Vermilya) Darrin. The father was a native of Massachusetts and the mother of New York; both died in Ohio. Mr. and Mrs. Stiles have seven children, viz.: Minerva E., born February 9, 1855, wife of David Wallace of Bureau Township; Amanda A., born April 20, 1861, wife of Frank Wallace of Manlius Township; Sanford Marion, born April 27, 1864; Laura V., born May 4, 1867; Etta Florence, born December 11, 1869; George A., born March 29, 1873; Jesse F., born May 18, 1877. Mr. Stiles came to this county with little property, and has been successful, mostly through the growing of hogs for market. One year he sold 118 head of his own raising, which averaged 418 pounds. His farm in Sections 13 and 14 contains 286 acres, and 200 acres in Manlius Township. In politics he is a Democrat.
