Sarah Ann Vermilyea (UNKNOWN) born February 11, 1816 in New York, married May 12, 1834 at _____ John Samuel, son of Jonathan and Hannah (Lane) Lane who was born January 15, 1808 at Bedford, Massachusetts, died July 21, 1856, probably at New York, New York. She died August 24, 1878, at New York, New York, burial Green-wood Cemetery, Brooklyn, New York. No listing can be found for her or John Lane in the Green-wood Cemetery Index. Cerebral softening, paralysis of heart. Burial - Greenwood Aug 27 1878 (This calculates to February 14, 1816, 3 days off, but this is burial date)

1850 Federal Census New York, New York, 1st. Dist. 7th Ward: John L. Lane, age 42, born Massachusetts, Sally A., age 34, born New York; Hannah, age 15; George E., age 12; Eliza A., age 8; Ebenezer H., age 3; Wm E. McDonald, age 21, all born New York. 1860 Federal Census New York, New York, Dist. 7th Ward: Sarah Lane, age 40, born New York; Eliza, age 18, born New York; George, clerk, age 21, born New York; Ebenezer, age 13, born New York; Oliver, age 9. A number of other people living at same address including servants, clerks, etc. Sarah is actually listed with the family above them which is William Conroy, his wife is listed as Treva, no connection can be found to this family, they are corset makers. 1870 Federal Census New York, New York, Dist. 7th Ward: Sarah A. Lane, age 50, boarding H K, born New York; George, age 30, clerk in store, born New York; Ebenezer, age 23, clerk in store, born New York; Oliver, age 20, clerk in store, born New York. Again a number of people living at same address, this time down the list is William Vermillea, age 50, no occupation, born New York. Address is listed as housing between Market and Catherine.

The William Vermillea living in the boarding house with this family in 1870 is Unidentified William E. Vermilyea.

The children of Sarah Vermilyea Lane --- Hannah Beach, George E. Lane, Ebenezer H. Lane and Oliver A. Lane are all listed in the Probate notice of Dorcas Hyatt published in The Statesman, Yonkers, New York, dated November 20, 1886.

who was born January 1, 1830, died August 18, 1869. She married second February 22, 1875 James G. Beach who was born in 1842, died October __, 1898. She died June 11, 1895. Child with Theodore Van Riper: (1) Arline Letitia, born December 27, 1885, married May 18, 1869 Harrald T. Quartrup who was born February 4, 1853.

1880 Federal Census, New York, New York, E. D. 283: James Beach, age 40, druggist, born New York, parents born New York; Hannah, age 37, wife, born New York, parents born New York; V. R. Alene, age 17, daughter, at home, born New York, parents born New York, a number of boarders and servants, so it appear they have a boarding house appears to be on W. 24th St..

II. Mary Amelia, born January 12, 1837, died March 15, 1838.

III. George Edward, born January 20, 1839 in New York, married in 1872 Emma Middleton, died March 5, 1898. No children.

IV. Eliza Ann, born January 21, 1843 in New York, married October 13, 1869 Frank Chase Smith who was born January 19, 1843. Lived Brooklyn, New York. Child: (1) George Edward, born August 29, 1874. Employed in a piano warehouse. Could be more children, more names in the probate posting of Dorcas Hyatt. The Statesman, Yonkers, New York, November 20, 1886. New York Marriage 1686-1980 Eliza A. Lane, father: John S. Lane, mother: Sarah Vermilyen married October 13, 1869 at Manhattan, New York Frank C. Smith, father: Elisha, mother: Abigail Robinson.

V. Ebenezer Hayward, born November 6, 1848 in New York, married October 25, 1877 Catherine Murray who was born September 27, 1860, died after 1900. He died prior to 1900. Children: (1) Clair DeWitt, born September 4, 1878; (2) Arline Grace, born December 10, 1881; (3) Gertrude Evangeline, born March 1, 1884; (4) Ruth Cleaveland, born April 2, 1894. Marriage records of Manhattan, New York: Ebenezer H. Lane, parents John A. Lane and Sally A. Veniulye, married Kate Murry daughter of John and Mary Currie, dated September 2, 1878, Manhattan, New York.

1880 Federal Census New York, New York, Manhattan: Kittie Lane, age 20, lodger, dressmaker, born New York, parents born New York; Edward, age 32, lodger, born New York, parents born New York; Clair D., male, age 1, born New York, parents born New York. They are apparently in an apartment on East 14th St. 1900 Federal Census New York, New York, Manhattan, Dist 96: Katie Lane, born November 1861, age 38, widow, married 22 years, mother of 5 children, 4 living, born New York, father born Ireland, mother born England, dressmaker; Clair, son, born September 1878, age 21, single, born New York, parents born New York, salesman, dry goods store; Gertrude, daughter, born March 1883, age 17, single, born New York, parents born New York, sales lady, dry goods store: Ruth, daughter, born April 1893, age 7, born New York, parents born New York, at school. There are two lodgers, 2 male, 1 female, all late 20's with no occupation. In 1910 Clair Lane is married with two children, oldest age 2.
