William E. Vermilyea, (UNKNOWN) born about 1818 in New York, married Amelia _____ who was born about 1830 in New York, died probably between 1870 and 1880. It isn't known if he was married twice or if Phebe who appears on the 1850 Census and Amelia who appears on following records is the same person.

1850 Federal Census New York, New York, 10th Ward: William Vermilyea (in index as Vermelyra), age 28, butcher, born New York; Phebe, age 20, born New York; Oliver, age 1/12, Jane, age 1/12, all born in New York State. 1860 Federal Census New York, 19th Ward, New York City: Sophia Reynolds, age 16, born New York; (She is listed as head of household, living in a residence with two other families surname Pell and Ketchum. Sophia could not be located on census records in 1850) W. E. Vermilyine, age 42, butcher, born New York; Amelia, age 30, born New York; Oliver M., age 9, born New York; Mary E., age 6, born New York. 1870 Federal Census New York, New York, Ward 12, Dist. 10: William E. Vermilye, age 48, butcher, is living with a lot of other people in a hotel. Also another: 1870 Federal Census New York, New York, New York, Ward 7 Dist. 2 (2nd Enum) William Vermiler age 50, born New York, no occupation listed. Boarding house located at Market and Catherine. All of the rest of the boarders are in their 20's. Not located on the 1880 Census.

Index to Marriages and Deaths in the New York Herald Vol.III 1864-1870, by James P. Maher Amelia W. Vermilya, 6/5/1869. It can not be confirmed this is the same Amelia, however she does not appear in the 1870 census records.

1870 Federal Census New York, Westchester County, Rye: Oliver Verm ilea, age 19, born New York, gas fiter's apprentice, enumerator with George Cannon, age 42, gas fitter, and family. 1880 Federal Census New York, New York, Manhattan: Oliver Vermilyea, age 26, plumber, born New York, parents born New York; Mary, wife, age 22, born Ireland, parents born Ireland; Mary, daughter, age 2, born New York, father born New York, mother born Ireland, Mary McGraw, mother, widow, age 55, born Ireland, parents born Ireland, keeping house; Mary McGraw, daughter, single, age 17, born New York, servant, parents born Ireland; Eliza Ryan, other, widow, age 55, born Ireland, parents born Ireland, keeping house. Checked New York County and Westchester County in 1900 for everyone with first name Oliver, no listing.
