1850 Federal Census New Jersey, Essex, Clinton: William Vermilya, age 30, (In Index his year of birth is listed as 1824) shoemaker, born New York; Rebecca, age 25, born New Jersey; Heneryetta, age 5; William B., age 4; Hannah, age 2. All born New Jersey. They are enumerated in the household of Henry Little, age 40, born Germany, farmer; Catherine, age 34, born Germany, 4 children ages 1-7, all born in New Jersey, No connection can be made to this family. 1860 Federal Census New York, Orange, Cornwall, Canterbury Town: William Vermillea, age 40, shoemaker, born New York; Christina, age 28, born Scotland; Hanah, age 16; Anna (?), age 3; John, age 2. All born in New York State. Enumerated with Peter F.(?) Borland/ Brown ?????, age 44; wife Elizabeth, age 37; Phebe, age 16; Isaac (?), age 7; Alice, age 5; Abraham, age 2. 1870 New York, New York, Ward 7, Dist. 1: William Vermiller, age 50, no occupation listed, living in a boarding house -- this Wm? The boarding house keeper is Sarah A. Lane, age 50, boarding H K, born New York. She is Sarah A. Vermilyea, (see Sarah A. Vermilye Lane, unidentified). 1880 not located.

Searched 1870 for Christine Vermilyea, all Christine's born Scotland, nothing. Also searched for John Vermilyea and Anna of these ages, born New York, no records located.

1850 Federal Census New York Orange, Cornwall: Peter J. Brewer, age 33, laborer, born New York; Elizabeth A., age 27, born New York; Henry J., age 9; William J., age 7, Phebe A., age 5; Mary J., age 4; Sarah E., age 2. All born New York. 1870 Federal Census New York, Orange, Cornwall: Peter J. Brewer, age 52, wall layer, born New York; Elizabeth, age 48, born New York; Phebe A., age 25, servant, born New York; Adaline, age 18, servant, born New York; Isaac, age 20, laborer, born New York; Alice, age 14, born New York; Abraham, age 10, born New York. 1880 Federal Census New York, Orange, Cronwall: Elizabeth Brewer is a widow, Phebe still living with her and a son Robert, age 23, painter, his wife Mary, age 18 and two children Peter H., age 6 and Edith, age 12. It is not known if there is any connection to this family.

1860 Federal Census New Jersey, Essex, Orange: Henrietta Vermilye, age 16, born New Jersey, enumerated with William Bontau, age 68, shoemaker, born New Jersey; Maria, age 53, born New Jersey. 1870 Federal Census New Jersey, Essex, Orange: George Coogler, age 25, farmer, born New Jersey; Henrietta, age 25, keeping house, born New Jersey; William Bowden, age 79, shoemaker, born New Jersey. 1880 Federal Census New Jersey, Essex, South Orange: George Cngler, age 35, driver, born New Jersey, parents born New Jersey; Henrietta, wife, age 35, keeps house, born New Jersey, parents born New Jersey. 1895 New Jersey State Census Essex, East Orange, Ward 2: Bridget Cuglar, she is living with three other women with the surname McCally. George is not located. In 1900 George B. Cugles, living same location is married to Bridget, born Ireland.

S3. Hannah, born about 1848 in New Jersey. 1860 listed at Cornwall, Orange County, New York.
